Itinerary •

A: Yes, the houseboats typically have AC bedrooms. Please note that air conditioning works during nighttime hours (9 PM to 6 AM), unless otherwise specified or upgraded. This is one of the highlights of the Athirapally Package.

Q: Are meals included in the Athirapally Package?

A: Breakfast is included daily, and all meals are provided on the houseboat. Lunch and dinner on other days are at your own cost, allowing flexibility to explore Kerala's rich food culture.

Q: Is the itinerary suitable for children and senior citizens?
