After a relaxing breakfast on your final day, there's still time to soak in the vibe of Bir by visiting a few more cafes before you check out and begin your return journey to Delhi. By morning, you're back in the capital carrying memories of breathtaking landscapes, peaceful moments, and the unmatched thrill of flying. Famous Places to Visit in Bir Billing

1. Billing (Paragliding Take-Off Site)

Billing, situated at 2,400 meters, is one of the world's top paragliding take-off sites. Located 14 km

uphill from Bir, it offers thrilling flights with stunning views of the Dhauladhar range and Kangra Valley. The route to Billing is a scenic drive through pine forests and mountain curves. Even if you're not flying, it's worth visiting for peaceful picnics, vibrant sunsets, and fresh mountain air. It's a must-visit destination for adventure lovers and nature enthusiasts seeking an adrenaline rush or a serene spot to take in the Himalayas.

2. Bir (Landing Site & Town)

Bir is the cultural and adventure hub of the region, known as the landing site for paragliders. This peaceful town is filled with Tibetan monasteries, cosy cafés, eco-friendly guesthouses, and colourful prayer flags. The Tibetan Colony offers a rich cultural experience and delicious Tibetan cuisine. With gliders floating above and the Dhauladhar range in the backdrop, Bir creates a dreamy, relaxed vibe. It's perfect for those seeking both thrill and tranquillity. Whether sipping coffee in a scenic café or strolling through quiet trails, Bir provides a soulful Himalayan experience.

3. Sherabling Monastery

Tucked away in pine forests, Sherabling Monastery is a serene Buddhist monastery located near Bhattu village. It is an essential spiritual centre associated with the Karma Kagyu lineage. The monastery boasts intricate architecture, a grand prayer hall, and serene surroundings that are perfect for meditation. Visitors are welcomed by prayer flags and tall stupas, offering a calming atmosphere. The scenic route leading to the monastery makes the journey as beautiful as the destination itself. It's ideal for those seeking to explore Tibetan culture and spiritual practices amidst the natural surroundings.

4. Gunehar Waterfall

Gunehar Waterfall is a hidden gem near Bir, accessed via a short, scenic trek from Gunehar village. The trail winds through pine forests, rocky paths, and small streams, offering a peaceful connection with nature. The waterfall itself is modest but beautifully situated in a quiet, forested corner. It's perfect for a peaceful picnic, light trek, or nature photography. Best visited post-monsoon, it remains relatively untouched by crowds, making it a tranquil escape for those who want a raw and refreshing Himalayan experience.

5. Chokling Monastery

Located in Bir's Tibetan Colony, Chokling Monastery is known for its vibrant architecture, large stupa, and golden statue of Guru Rinpoche. It belongs to the Nyingma tradition and offers a peaceful retreat for visitors. The monastery grounds are ideal for a leisurely stroll, meditation, or simply immersing oneself in the serene spiritual energy of the place. During prayer times, you may hear monks chanting, adding to the sacred ambience. Easily accessible from the main town, this monastery is a blend of cultural richness, beauty, and serenity.

6. Deer Park Institute

Deer Park Institute is a centre for classical Indian wisdom, promoting teachings on Buddhist philosophy, meditation, and mindful living. Located in Bir, it offers courses, retreats, and workshops open to all visitors. Even if you're not attending a program, you can visit the peaceful campus and meditate in its open spaces. The institute attracts spiritual seekers and thinkers from across the globe. Surrounded by calm and natural beauty, it offers a serene retreat from regular travel, making it a unique stop on your Bir Billing journey.

7. Bir Tea Factory

The Bir Tea Factory offers a glimpse into the region's tea culture and local economy. You can take a short tour to see how Kangra tea is processed from leaf plucking to drying. The air is fragrant with fresh tea, and visitors can often enjoy tastings. The nearby tea gardens also offer scenic walks and great photo opportunities. It's a great place to learn something new and take home fresh, locally grown tea as a souvenir from your Bir Billing adventure.

FAQs •

Q: Why is Bir Billing famous for paragliding?

A: Bir Billing is Asia's top paragliding destination and one of the world's best due to its ideal wind conditions, thermal uplifts, and stunning Himalayan views. It also hosted the 2015 Paragliding World Cup.

Q: What is the cost of paragliding in Bir Billing?

A: Tandem paragliding usually costs between ₹2,500 and ₹3,500 per person, depending on the flight duration (15-30 minutes). Prices may vary with season and operator.

Q: What is the paragliding height in Bir Billing?

A: The take-off point is at Billing (approximately 2,400 meters), and the landing site is in Bir (1,525 meters), resulting in a total drop of around 900 meters—one of the highest paragliding drops in India.

Q: Is paragliding in Bir Billing safe?

A: Yes, it is generally safe when done with licensed pilots and certified operators. However, like any adventure sport, it carries some risk. Always follow safety instructions and check equipment.

Q: Have there been any paragliding accidents in Bir Billing?

A: While paragliding is mostly safe, occasional accidents have occurred due to weather changes or pilot error. Choose experienced, certified pilots and avoid flying in unstable weather.

Q: What's the best time to visit Bir Billing?

A: The best times for paragliding are March to May and October to November, when the weather is pleasant. Avoid the peak monsoon (July–August) due to rain and flight restrictions.

Q: What's the weather like in Bir Billing year-round?

A: Summer (Apr-Jun): Pleasant (15-25°C) Monsoon (Jul-Aug): Rainy, not ideal for flying Autumn (Sep-Nov): Clear skies, perfect for paragliding Winter (Dec-Feb): Cold (5-15°C), occasional snow

Q: What is the distance to Bir Billing from major cities?

A: Delhi to Bir Billing: 520 km (11-13 hrs) Chandigarh to Bir Billing: 280 km (7-8 hrs) Dharamshala to Bir Billing: 65 km (2

hrs) Mandi to Bir Billing: 100 km (3 hrs)
