After settling into the hotel and taking a short rest, explore the local attractions, including the vibrant Tibetan market, Dal Lake, Naddi Hills, Bhagsu Waterfall, St. John Church, and the serene Dalai Lama Temple. The next day, enjoy a beautiful sunrise over the Dhauladhar Ranges before heading to Bir, located 63 km away. In Bir, you can experience the thrill of paragliding (at an extra cost) and unwind in charming local cafes. Wake up to the sight of paragliders soaring in the sky, and after breakfast, either opt for more paragliding or visit nearby spots like Sherabling Monastery and the Tibetan market. The return journey to Delhi begins in the evening, concluding the trip with unforgettable memories of the peaceful hills and thrilling experiences.

Things to Do in Dharamshala, Bir Billing Package

1. Dalai Lama Temple Complex

Visit this peaceful spiritual centre in McLeod Ganj. The temple houses Tibetan monks and is adorned with colour full prayer flags that flutter in the wind, creating a calm and spiritual atmosphere. It's ideal for meditation, quiet reflection, and gaining insight into Tibetan Buddhist practices.

2. Bhagsunag Waterfall and Temple

Trek through scenic trails to reach the refreshing Bhagsunag Waterfall, and stop at the ancient Bhagsunag Temple dedicated to Lord Shiva. It beautifully combines natural beauty, spiritual significance, and a touch of adventure for an enriching experience.

3. Explore McLeod Ganj Market

Walk through lively streets where you'll find colourful Tibetan souvenirs, detailed thangka artwork, locally made jewellery, and soft woollens that reflect the region's rich culture and craftsmanship. The market also features cosy cafes and bookshops, perfect for soaking in the hill town's cultural vibe.

4. Naddi View Point

A tranquil spot that provides sweeping panoramic views of the majestic Dhauladhar mountain range. Catch the magic by visiting at sunrise or sunset, when the scenery comes alive with color. It's a calm spot for photographers, couples, and nature lovers.

5. St. John in the Wilderness Church

This neo-Gothic church is set amid deodar forests. Built in 1852, it offers a tranquil retreat and a touch of colonial charm. The peaceful graveyard adds to its quiet beauty.

6. Tibetan Museum

Located near the Dalai Lama Temple, this museum highlights Tibet's history, struggles, and cultural identity through photographs and exhibits. It's an emotional and educational stop for those interested in human rights and history.

7. Paragliding in Bir Billing

Fly over the stunning Kangra Valley and pine forests in one of the world's top paragliding destinations. The adrenaline rush, combined with breathtaking aerial views, makes it a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

8. Sherabling Monastery

Tucked in a forest near Bir, this massive monastery complex offers peace, detailed artwork, and Buddhist teachings. It's a wonderful place to meditate, take photos, or simply enjoy the calm surroundings.

9. Visit Bir Tibetan Colony

Explore Bir's Tibetan charm by visiting peaceful monasteries, browsing unique cultural stores, and tasting traditional flavours at local eateries. It's a quiet, spiritual place perfect for connecting with Tibetan heritage and daily life.

10. Sunset at Billing

Billing, the paragliding take-off point, also offers surreal sunsets. Watch the sky turn golden as it dips behind the mountains. A perfect spot for reflection and photography before heading back.

11. Café Hopping in Bir

Bir has a lively café scene with rooftop spots, garden cafes, and bakeries. Enjoy a mix of Tibetan, Himachali, and continental cuisine while relaxing amidst stunning mountain views and a calm atmosphere.

Itinerary •

Day 1: Delhi to Dharamshala | Distance: 472 km | 09-10 hours by vehicle

- Begin your overnight journey from Delhi in a Volvo bus or private cab.
- The journey covers around 472 km and typically takes 9 to 10 hours by road.
- Arrive in Dharamshala the next morning, ready to explore.

- Start with a stroll through the vibrant Tibetan market.
- Visit the serene Dal Lake and take in the stunning views from the Naddi Hills.
- Discover the beauty of Bhagsu Waterfall, visit the historic St. John in the Wilderness Church and experience the peaceful atmosphere of the Dalai Lama Temple.
- In the evening, head back to your hotel for a delicious dinner and a restful night.

Day 3: Dharamshala to Bir | Distance: 63 km | Time: 02 to 03 hrs

- Begin the day with a breathtaking sunrise over the majestic Dhauladhar Ranges.
- Enjoy a hearty breakfast before setting out for Bir.
- Try paragliding in Bir (available at an additional cost).
- Spend your afternoon relaxing and exploring quaint local cafes.

Day 4: Local Sightseeing and Depart | Checkout Time: 11:00 am

- Wake up to a scenic view of paragliders soaring through the sky.

- Alternatively, explore nearby attractions like Sherabling Monastery and the Tibetan market.
- Depart for Delhi in the evening, wrapping up your memorable trip to the hills.
