On your final day, you'll explore Dharamshala's Tea Gardens, the Shaheed Samarak, a tribute to brave soldiers, and the HPCA Cricket Stadium, one of the most beautiful stadiums in the world. After that, it's time to return, carrying the magic of the mountains with you.

Things to do in Dharamshala

1. Bhagsu Waterfall

Bhagsu Waterfall is a must-visit destination in Dharamshala, particularly for nature enthusiasts. A short trek leads you to this scenic cascade surrounded by lush greenery. The calm, clear waters and the peaceful atmosphere make it perfect for relaxation, photography, and enjoying a break

from the hustle of city life.

2. Bhagsu Nag Temple

The Bhagsu Nag Temple is an ancient Shiva temple renowned for its spiritual ambience and rich history. Located near Bhagsu Waterfall, it attracts both devotees and tourists. The temple is set amidst stunning natural surroundings, and many visit to offer prayers, meditate, or simply experience the calm Himalayan setting.

3. McLeodganj and Tibetan Market

McLeodganj is the heart of Tibetan culture in Dharamshala. Wander through its lively streets, try Tibetan delicacies like momos and thukpa, and shop for handicrafts at the Tibetan Market. From handmade jewellery to prayer flags, the market is ideal for finding unique souvenirs and gifts.

4. Dalai Lama Temple Complex

The Dalai Lama Temple Complex, also called Tsuglagkhang, is a spiritual centre where visitors can witness monks chanting and spinning prayer wheels. It's a peaceful place to learn about Tibetan Buddhism, meditate, or simply observe the serene surroundings. Sometimes, you may even catch teachings or public prayers.

5. Namgyal Monastery

Namgyal Monastery is closely associated with the Dalai Lama and is one of the most important Tibetan monasteries. It serves as a centre for Buddhist learning and meditation. The monastery is open to visitors, allowing you to observe monks studying and chanting, creating a profoundly spiritual and calming experience.

6. Naddi Village

It's a quiet, less crowded spot compared to McLeodganj, perfect for nature walks and photography. Spend time enjoying the cool mountain breeze, watch the sunset, or interact with locals to learn about traditional Himachali village life.

7. Dal Lake

Dal Lake in Dharamshala is a small yet serene spot surrounded by deodar trees. It's an ideal place for a peaceful walk, picnics, or simply sitting by the water. The lake holds a sacred significance for the local community, and a small Shiva temple on its banks adds to its spiritual significance.

8. Dharamshala Tea Gardens

The Tea Gardens of Dharamshala offer a scenic escape into the world of tea cultivation. Walk through the lush green plantations, see how tea is grown and harvested, and enjoy the fresh mountain air. Some estates offer local tea tastings, allowing you to savour the taste of freshly brewed Kangra tea.

9. St. John in the Wilderness Church

This beautiful neo-Gothic church is nestled in a forest. St. John in the Wilderness, built in 1852, is renowned for its stunning stained-glass windows and serene surroundings. It's a peaceful place to reflect, surrounded by tall deodar trees, away from the noise of the tourist areas.

10. HPCA Cricket Stadium

The HPCA Cricket Stadium is one of the world's highest cricket grounds, set against the stunning Dhauladhar mountains. Whether or not there's a match, visiting this stadium is worth it for the views alone. The colourful stands and open atmosphere make it a popular stop for tourists and cricket fans.

Day 1: Delhi to Dharamshala | Dist: 472 km | Time: 09 to 10 hrs

- Finally, your cab will drop you at the Dharamshala bus station to board a Volvo bus back to Delhi.
