Itinerary •

Day 1: Pick up from Leh Airport | Dist: 10 km to 12 km | Altitude: 3300 m to 2600 m

- Upon arrival at the airport, you will be greeted by a cab ready to transfer you.
- After checking into your hotel in Leh and taking some time to unwind, you'll explore Leh by visiting the historic Leh Palace, the serene Shanti Stupa, and the bustling Leh Bazaar.

Meals: Dinner

Night: Stay at the hotel in Leh

Day 2: Leh Local Sightseeing | 70 km to 90 km | Altitude: 3300 m to 2600 m

- Following breakfast, set out for a local sightseeing excursion.
- Explore the Hall of Fame, Spituk Monastery, and Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, then experience the wonders of Magnetic Hill, the confluence at Sangam, and enjoy rafting at the Rafting Point (seasonal, available in summer).

- In the evening, return to your stay.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Night: Stay at the hotel in Leh

Day 3: Leh to Nubra | Dist: 160 km | Altitude: 3500 m to 5354 m

- Today, after breakfast, you'll head towards Nubra Valley, crossing Khardung La pass.
- Visit Diskit Monastery, explore the Sand Dunes of Hunder, and try an optional camel ride.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Night: Stay at a hotel/camping in Hunder

Day 4: Nubra to Turtuk | Dist: 80 km | Altitude: 3048 m to 3200 m

- Wake up to the stunning Karakoram mountain views.
- Enjoy breakfast before setting out for Turtuk Village, the last Indian village in this region.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Night: Stay at a cottage/camp in Hunder

Day 5: Nubra Valley to Pangong | Dist: 200 km | Altitude: 3100 m to 4814 m

- Today's journey takes you to Pangong Tso after breakfast.
- En route, stops are made at the picturesque villages of Shayok, Durbuk, and Tangtse.
- In the evening, settle into your accommodation near Pangong Lake.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Night: Stay at the homestay/Hotel in Pangong

Day 6: Pangong to Hanle via Tsaka LA (Observatory Star Gazing) | Dist: 200 km | Altitude: 4814 m to 4500 m

- Post breakfast, drive to Hanle, crossing the picturesque Tsaka La Pass.
- Visit the ancient Hanle Monastery and enjoy a glimpse of the night sky at the Hanle Observatory.
- In the evening, check into your accommodation in Hanle.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Night: Stay at the Hotel in Hanle

Day 7: Hanle to Leh | Dist: 313 km | Altitude: 4500 m to 3100 m

- Today, after breakfast, drive back to Leh.
- Stopping along the way at Shey Palace, Rancho School, and Thiksey Monastery.
- After reaching Leh, check into the hotel.

Day 8: Departure | Morning 10:00 am

- Following breakfast, you will start your journey back home.

Q: What is Hanle in Ladakh known for?

A:

Hanle is a remote village in eastern Ladakh, famous for its pristine night skies, stargazing opportunities, and the Indian Astronomical Observatory, one of the world's highest observatories. It's also part of India's first Dark Sky Reserve.

Q: What is the temperature in Hanle?

A:

- Summer (May–September): 5°C to 20°C (cold and dry)
- Winter (October–March): -15°C to -30°C (extremely cold, often inaccessible)

For the current temperature, we recommend using real-time weather apps.

Q: What is special about the Hanle Observatory?

A:

The Indian Astronomical Observatory (IAO) in Hanle is situated at an elevation of 4,500 meters (14,764 feet). It is one of the world's highest observatories, featuring advanced telescopes for deep-sky observation. Public access is limited, but you can view the premises from outside.

Q: Why is Hanle famous for its night sky?

A:

Hanle offers one of the clearest, darkest skies in India, with minimal light pollution and stable atmospheric conditions, making it a haven for astronomers and astrophotographers.

Q: What is the Hanle Dark Sky Reserve?

A:

In 2022, Hanle was designated as India's first Dark Sky Reserve, a protected area dedicated to conserving the pristine night sky for scientific research and promoting astro-tourism.

Q: What is the distance from Leh to Hanle?

A:

- Distance: Approximately 254 km
- Travel Time: About 9–10 hours by road, depending on the route and conditions.

Popular route: Leh → Chumathang → Nyoma → Loma → Hanle.

Stargazing & Astrophotography

Known for its crystal-clear skies, Hanle is among the best places in India for stargazing. Its clear, pollution-free skies offer an unparalleled view of:

- The Milky Way Galaxy
- Shooting stars and meteor showers
- Planets, constellations, and distant galaxies

2. Visit the Indian Astronomical Observatory (IAO)

Hanle is home to the world's highest optical telescope at the Indian Astronomical Observatory (14,764 feet). While public entry inside the observatory is restricted, you can tour the surroundings and learn about its importance from the locals.

3. Explore Hanle Monastery (Hanle Gompa)

This 17th-century Drukpa Kagyu Monastery offers stunning views of the Hanle plains. It's perched on a hill and provides insight into Ladakh's rich spiritual and cultural heritage.

4. Experience the Hanle Dark Sky Reserve

Hanle is India's first Dark Sky Reserve, protected to maintain the quality of its night sky. You can participate in:

- Night sky tours (organised by some locals and homestays)
- Astronomy workshops (seasonal)

5. Visit Remote Villages and Interact with Locals

Located in the remote Changthang region, Hanle is home to the Changpa nomads. Engage with the local community to learn about their rich cultural heritage.

6. Bird Watching & Wildlife Spotting

The Hanle region is part of the Changthang Wildlife Sanctuary, where you might spot:

- Black-necked cranes (summer)
- Kiangs (Tibetan wild asses)
- Marmots and other high-altitude wildlife

7. Enjoy the Scenic Drives

Routes to Hanle offer breathtaking landscapes, including:

- Tsaka La Pass
- Loma Bend

- Changthang Plateau
- Views of the Indo-China border region (from a distance)

8. Visit Nearby Attractions

If time allows, explore nearby places like:

- Umling La Pass – the world's highest motorable pass
- Nyoma and Loma Villages
