From Manali, the journey continued through the lush greenery of the Kullu Valley toward the tranquil town of Kasol, often called "The Mini Israel of India." With the sound of the Parvati River nearby and pine forests stretching far and wide, Kasol offered a perfect retreat for quiet moments, lazy café-hopping, and soaking in the region's spiritual calm.

The next chapter led to Manikaran, where natural hot springs and the spiritual buzz of the place offered a unique blend of relaxation and devotion. From there, the trail ascended to Tosh, a secluded village perched above the valley, accessible only by crossing a bridge and trekking for 20 minutes along scenic trails. The reward was a night wrapped in mountain silence, surrounded by pure wilderness. The final morning offered views of the majestic Parvati Valley and a chance to explore the hidden gems of Kutla, Kalga, and Pulga, charming villages untouched by the rush of the modern world. As the sun dipped behind the peaks, it was time to head back to Delhi, with a

heart full of memories and a soul refreshed by the mountains' magic.

Itinerary •

Day 1: Delhi to Manali | Dist: 529 km | Time: 12 to 16 hr | Altitude: 300 m to 2050 m

- Travel from Delhi to Manali by road, passing through the scenic states of Haryana and Himachal Pradesh.
- The drive usually takes around 12 to 14 hours, with your arrival in Manali expected the next day.

Night: Overnight journey by bus/cab

Day 2: Manali Local | Check-In: 11:00 am | Sightseeing: 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm

- After reaching Manali, you'll check in at your hotel, relax for a while, and refresh yourself.
- Once you're ready, the day unfolds with local sightseeing that captures the town's charm and culture.
- Then, wander through the rustic lanes of Old Manali, filled with cosy cafes, live music spots, and a laid-back vibe.
- You'll also visit the Clubhouse and historic Hadimba Temple.
- Finally, unwind in the peaceful surroundings of Dhungri Van Vihar, a serene forest park ideal for a quiet walk or simply soaking in the mountain air.

Day 3: Solang Valley Sightseeing | Sightseeing Time: 10:00 am to 6:00 pm

- After enjoying your morning tea and breakfast, you'll head out for an exciting day trip to Solang Valley, a hub for adventure and natural beauty.
- After soaking in the fun and breathtaking views, your journey continues with a visit to the remarkable Atal Tunnel, one of the world's highest highway tunnels.

Day 4: Depart for Kasol via Kullu | Dist: 81 km | Time: 02 to 04 hr | Altitude: 2050 m to 1580 m

- After enjoying your morning tea and breakfast, check out of the hotel and begin your journey to Kasol, often referred to as "The Mini Israel of India"
- Upon arrival, you'll check into your hotel and take some time to relax before heading out to explore the serene beauty of this riverside town.
- Surrounded by lush pine forests and the calming flow of the Parvati River, Kasol offers a peaceful atmosphere, perfect for leisurely walks, visiting quaint cafes, and soaking in the scenic mountain views.

Day 5: Kasol to Tosh | Dist: 21 km | Time: 02 to 04 hr | Altitude: 1580 m to 2400 m Day 5: Kasol to Tosh

- In the morning, after freshening up, you'll set off for Manikaran, a sacred pilgrimage site famous for its natural hot water springs.
- After exploring the area, you'll continue your drive towards the village of Tosh, located deep in the Parvati Valley.
- Since Tosh is not directly accessible by vehicle, you'll cross a small bridge and trek for about 20 minutes through picturesque mountain paths to reach your hotel.
- Once there, you can relax and take in the serene beauty of this peaceful Himalayan village, where you'll spend the night.

Day 6: Explore Tosh and Depart | Checkout: 11:00 am | Depart: 3:00 to 7:00 pm

- Wake up to the stunning views of the Parvati Valley and enjoy a hearty breakfast amidst the serene mountain surroundings.
- Afterwards, you'll have the opportunity to explore the nearby hidden gems of Kutla, Kalga, and Pulga.
- In the evening, after a day filled with exploration and scenic beauty, you'll begin your return journey to Delhi, carrying unforgettable memories of the mountains with you.

FAQs •

Q: How long is the journey from Delhi to Manali?

A: The distance from Delhi to Manali is approximately 529 km, and the journey takes around 12 to 16 hours by road, depending on traffic and weather conditions. Travellers usually prefer an overnight bus or cab to reach Manali comfortably by morning.

Q: What is the altitude range covered in this trip?

A: The trip takes you from the plains of Delhi at 300 meters to the mountains of Manali and Tosh, reaching up to an altitude of around 2,400 meters above sea level.

Q: What type of accommodation is provided during the tour?

A: Comfortable standard or deluxe hotels are provided in Manali, Kasol, and Tosh. Rooms are equipped with basic amenities like attached bathrooms, hot water, and cosy bedding suitable for mountain weather.

Q: What kind of meals are included in the package?

A: The itinerary includes breakfast and dinner at hotels from Day 2 onwards. Meals during the overnight bus or cab journeys (Delhi–Manali and Tosh–Delhi) are omitted.

Q: What activities are included in Manali sightseeing?

A: Day 2 includes local sightseeing covering the Hadimba Temple, Clubhouse, Old Manali, and Dhungri Van Vihar. You can explore cafes, enjoy shopping, and soak in the Himalayan vibe.

Q: What can I expect at Solang Valley and Atal Tunnel?

A: Solang Valley is a paradise for adventure lovers, offering paragliding, skiing, ATV rides, and ziplining (activities at your own cost). The Atal Tunnel, one of the highest road tunnels in the world, offers a breathtaking drive and stunning mountain views.

Q: How far is Kasol from Manali, and what's special about it?

A: Kasol is about 81 km from Manali and takes around 2–4 hours to reach by car. Known as the “Mini Israel of India,” Kasol offers riverside cafes, serene views, and a laid-back mountain vibe along the Parvati River.

Q: What places can I explore near Tosh

A: You can trek or walk to nearby scenic spots like Kutla, Kalga, and Pulga villages - known for their apple orchards, cafes, and stunning valley views. These places offer perfect offbeat experiences for photographers and trekkers

Q: What is the return journey like from Tosh to Delhi?

A: After breakfast on Day 6, you'll start your journey back to Delhi in the evening via a Volvo bus or private cab. It's an overnight trip that concludes the next morning, wrapping up your Himalayan adventure.

Q: Is this trip suitable for beginners or families?

A: Yes, this itinerary suits beginners, families, and groups. The trekking involved is minimal (20–30 minutes to Tosh), and most places are easily accessible by vehicle.

Q: Are there ATMs and mobile network facilities available?

A: ATMs are available in Manali and Kasol, but not in Tosh, so carry sufficient cash. Mobile networks like Jio and Airtel work well in Manali and Kasol but are weak or unavailable in Tosh.

Q: What is the best time to plan this trip?

A: The best time to visit Manali-Kasol-Tosh-Tosh is from March to June and September to November, when the weather is pleasant and roads remain open. Winter months (December-February) offer snow but may cause travel delays.
