An optional elephant ride adds another memorable moment, offering a gentle exploration of the area from a different vantage point.

After soaking in the natural wonders of Thekkady, the journey flows seamlessly into the serene waterways of Alleppey. Often referred to as the "Venice of the East," Alleppey offers an entirely different landscape, one of calm canals, lush paddy fields, and rustic village life. Upon arrival, a traditionally designed houseboat becomes your floating retreat as you begin a leisurely cruise through Kerala's backwaters. These backwaters are not just scenic; they are alive with culture. As the boat glides through quiet waters, everyday life along the banks unfolds like a slow film, children waving from footbridges, fishermen hauling in their nets, and women balancing pots on their heads as they return from the market.

The surroundings are postcard-perfect, with lines of coconut trees reflecting on the water's surface, small shrines peeking out from thick foliage, and narrow canal paths winding through villages that seem untouched by time. The slow rhythm of the houseboat, the soft lull of the water, and the rich tapestry of local life create a soothing experience that allows travellers to disconnect from the chaos of the world completely.
