Day 1: Pick up from Leh Airport | Dist: 10 km to 12 km | Altitude: 3300 m to 2600 m

- Airport pickup and hotel check-in at Leh.
- Once refreshed, begin your local sightseeing with Leh Palace, Shanti Stupa, and a stroll through Leh Market.

Night: Stay at the hotel in Leh

Day 2: Leh Local Sightseeing | Dist: 70 km to 90 km | Altitude: 3300 m to 2600 m

- Today, after breakfast, visit the Hall of Fame, Spituk Monastery, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, Magnetic Hill, Sangam, and Rafting Point.
- Conclude the day by returning to your hotel.

Night: Stay at the hotel in Leh

Day 3: Leh to Khardung La to Nubra | Dist: 160 km | Altitude: 3100 m to 5354 m

- Travel to Nubra Valley via Khardung La Pass.
- Visit the Diskit Monastery, Hunder Village, and the Sand Dunes, with the option to take a camel ride.
- Later, check into your Nubra Valley stay.

Night: Stay at a hotel/homestay in Nubra Valley

Day 4: Explore Turtuk Village | Dist: 80 km | Altitude: 3048 m to 3200 m

- Today's journey takes you to Turtuk, the last village on India's northern frontier.
- Explore Turtuk Gompa, where you can seek blessings while enjoying the peaceful ambience of apricot orchards.
- The village's rich cultural heritage provides an exceptional opportunity to experience life in one of India's most remote communities.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Night: Stay at a hotel/homestay in Nubra Valley

Day 5: Nubra Valley to Pangong | Dist: 200 km | Altitude: 3048 m to 4814 m

- After waking up to the majestic Karakoram ranges, embark on a memorable drive to Pangong Tso, one of Ladakh's most breathtaking high-altitude lakes.
- The journey takes you through the picturesque villages of Shayok, Durbuk, and Tangtse.
- Spend the night by the tranquil shores of Pangong Lake.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Night: Stay at the cottage/camps in Pangong Tso

Day 6: Pangong to Tso Moriri via Saga LA | Dist: 220 km | Altitude: 4814 m to 4295 m

- Start your day with a nourishing breakfast before setting off from Pangong to Tso Moriri via Saga La.
- The journey unfolds across the Changthang Plateau, revealing snow-capped mountains, shimmering lakes, and remote Himalayan villages untouched by time.
- Later, unwind at your accommodation near Tso Moriri.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Night: Stay at camp/hotel in Tso Moriri

Day 7: Tso Moriri to Leh | Dist: 220 km | Altitude: 4295 m to 3100 m

- After a peaceful morning at Tso Moriri, drive back to Leh
- En route visits to Tso Kar Lake, Puga Hot Springs, Puga Village, Thiksey Monastery, Rancho School, and Shey Palace.
- Evening arrival at your hotel

Day 8: Drop off at Leh Airport | Morning 10:00 am

- After breakfast, check out of the hotel and proceed to Leh Airport.
- The tour ends with sweet memories of Leh.

- Winter (October–March): -10°C to -20°C (extremely cold; usually inaccessible)

For the current temperature, it's best to check real-time weather apps like AccuWeather or Windy.

Q: How far is Turtuk Village from Nubra Valley?

From Hunder (Nubra Valley) to Turtuk, the distance is around 80 km, which takes 2 to 3 hours by road.

Q: How can I reach Turtuk Village from Leh?

- Route: Leh - Khardung La - Diskit - Hunder - Turtuk
- Distance: About 205 km
- Time: Approximately 6–8 hours by road, depending on road and weather conditions.
